Dress Guidelines

General guideline for men and women: Neck to the knees and loose.

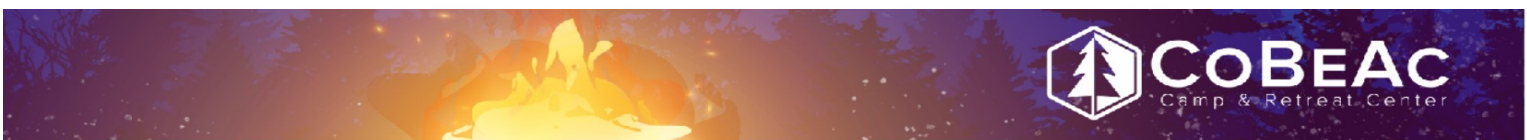
Guys Clothing Shorts should come to the middle of the knee, but should not be worn during the evening services. All shirts must have sleeves: no tank tops. Bring clothes that would be comfortable, yet conservative, for recreational activities. Avoid wearing clothing with inappropriate advertisement.

Girls Clothing All shorts worn for the daily activities must come to the middle of the knee. Loose-fitting slacks are acceptable for recreational activities. Shirts must have sleeves: no tank tops or spaghetti strap tops should be worn. Avoid wearing clothing with inappropriate advertisement.

Swim time is open for entire families so please keep this in mind when packing swimwear. We request that anyone over 3rd grade wear a dark t-shirt and knee-length shorts during swim time.

Housing Requests

Housing Options

Family Perfect: Cabins that sleep 8-10 guests comfortably with in-room, private, modern bathrooms.

Hillside Lodge: Rooms that sleep up to 4 guests with in-room, private, modern bathrooms. (Ideal for couples or small families.)

RV Parking: Outdoor sites located at the lake for RV's, trailers, and tents with close access to separate men and ladies bathrooms and shower facilities.

Food Allergies

Our kitchen is equipped to provide meals for campers with food allergies. Please inform the office if your camper will need assistance with allergies, including gluten, dairy, lactose, nuts, etc. We cannot accommodate special requests if campers do not have an allergy.

Medications

Our Health Staff always keep First Aid and emergency equipment with them around the campsite. If your camper requires extra medical attention, please contact our camp office.

Camper Check

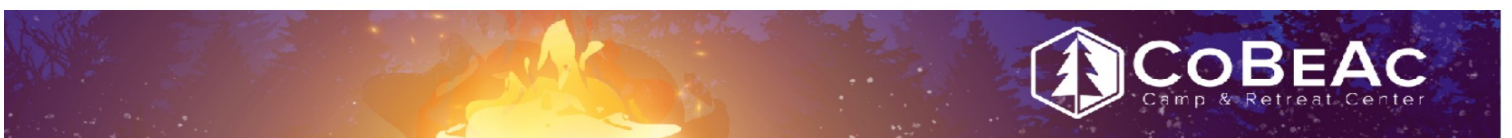
Please check your child for head lice before sending them to camp.

Health and Safety due to COVID 19

For Summer Camp and Adult Retreats, Camp CoBeAc has a policy that campers must be healthy and not running a fever (without fever reducing medication) for at least a full 72 hours before attending a camp or retreat. We already are in the practice of having to tell those that inquire about recent sickness that they must remain home until well and without a fever for a minimum of 24 hours, but have extended the time in response to the Covid-19 illness. Campers are monitored for health and safety by their counselors, the health tech team, and CoBeAc staff. Any camper who is believed to become sick at camp is immediately isolated to the health center where their needs are assessed and after initial care is given, arrangements are made for the camper's dismissal from camp to home.
